1) Are you currently unemployed?

Yes	36%
No	58%
Skipped	6%

2) Are you covered under a health insurance plan?

Yes	88%
No	11%
Skipped	1%

3) Have you switched electric generation providers since the removal of rate caps?

Yes	44%
No	54%
Skipped	1%

4) *Do you support the governor's plan to lower the sales tax, but expand it to cover additional items and services?

Yes	11%
No	86%
Skipped	3%

5) **Do you support the governor's plan to increase education funding by more than 7 percent when we are facing a \$500 million budget deficit?

Yes	7%
No	92%
Skipped	1%

Notes:

*The governor's plan was not included in the final version of state budget.

**Education funding was increased by \$250 million or 5.13 percent and we actually ended the 2009-10 fiscal year with a \$1 billion budget deficit.
